2013: Selection of World Team

- 1. The President will appoint an individual to selection and manage NFAA archers attending IFAA World Championships. NFAA's Style team will be composed of archers registered for the shoot. Previous NFAA Champions will be given priority if they are tied with other archers registered.
- 2. Young Adults, Adults and Veterans both male and female are eligible to be on the team.
- 3. Professional, Senior, Junior and Cub archers are not eligible.
- 4. Archers must be registered for the event to be considered for the team.
- 5. All NFAA archers registered for the IFAA World Field Archery Championships will send their contact information (email and cell phone) and current scores (Field, Hunter, Animal) and where they shot them (National, Sectional and NAFAC scores are preferred) to the NFAA Executive Secretary who will forward it to the Team Captain. This will allow for selecting the best team and communication amongst the team.
- Styles that are not competed at NFAA(currently) Bowhunter Freestyle Limited and Competitive Bowhunter can qualify at the previous years North American Field Archery Championships (NAFAC).
- 7. The IFAA shooting styles are now divided into four groups, each with their own shooting styles grouped together allowing for a team with a maximum of nine archers and a minimum of four archers.
  - Group 1 = Freestyle & Freestyle Bowhunter
  - Group 2 = Freestyle Limited or Freestyle Limited Recurve and Freestyle Bowhunter Limited
  - Group 3 = Barebow Compound or Barebow Recurce and Competitive Bowhunter and Traditional
  - Group 4 = Longbow

- 8. Points for the team are scored by how close you are shooting towards the IFAA World Record with the team getting the highest points from each group. Daily points are calculated from the daily score, expressed as a percentage of the world record, as it stands at the start of the tournament, of each individual division in each shooting style. E.g. if the world record in a style is 500 and the archer in the same style shoots 468, the day score of that archer will be  $468/500 \times 100 = 93.60$  points. The maximum points each day is limited to 100 points.
  - 9. A predetermined set amount, set by the Council, will be paid to each member to help with expenses.
- 10. The World Team shall be submitted to the President, Vice President, and the Executive Secretary for final approval.
- 11. The team shall be supplied with Team Shirts to be worn during the opening ceremonies and while receiving awards.

#### **Hunter Freestyle Bowhunter:**

- 1. A maximum of (5) five fixed reference points: Points of attachment shall not be considered reference points. A line running vertically from its top attachment in the pin guard to its bottom attachment in the pin guard would be legal. Sighting reference points, string peep (with or without a lens) and/or kisser button may not be moved during a round. Scopes, clickers and draw checks are not allowed. A round or oval housing around the points of reference is not considered a scope as long as no lens is used. No additional pin guard may be used. A sight pin consisting of a housing with a hole through it, that does not contain a fixed reference point within the hole, is not allowed.
- 2. Release aids will be permitted. In the case of physical disability of the arms or hands, a chew strap may be used in place of fingers or release aids.
- 3. A pinguard mounted on the sight, and a level mounted anywhere will be legal in this style of shooting, provided that there are no additional marks or blemishes on either of these items that could be used for sighting.
- 4. A string of suitable material with a center serving and end servings of the same or different color than the string may be used. One consistent nocking point only is permitted. Nocking point locators shall not extend more than ½ inch above or below the arrow nock when at full draw. Brush buttons and string silencers properly attached will be legal.
- 5. One anchor point only is permitted.
- 6. All arrows shall be identical in size, length, weight, and fletching with allowances for wear and tear.
- 7. Brush buttons, string silencer, positioned no closer than midway between the nocking

point and where the string touches the wheel/cam, and bow quiver installed on the opposite side of the sight window, with no part of the quiver or attachments visible in the sight window are legal. One straight stabilizer, coupling device included if used, which cannot exceed 12 inches at any time, as measured from the back of the bow, V-bar, counterbalance and string dampeners may be used.

- 8. An archer will not be permitted to change the draw weight of the bow during a round.
- 9. During a round no adjustments may be made to the bow and its related equipment unless equipment failure is recognized

#### **Hunter Traditional:**

- 1. This style of shooting is for those who wish to compete with the Recurve or Longbow.
- 2. No device of any kind, including arrow rest, that can be used for sighting will be used or attached to the archers' equipment.
- 3. There shall be no device, mechanical or otherwise, in the sight window except the arrow rest, arrow plate or plunger button.
- 4. No part of the arrow rest may extend more than ¼ inch above the arrow in the sight window.
- 5. No clickers, drawchecks or levels will be allowed. No laminations, marks or blemishes on the face of the bow or in the sight window will be legal.
- 6. The string may be of any color but must have a single color center serving. One single nocking point is permitted. One or two nock locators may be used. Brush buttons and string silencers, properly placed may be used. Any other marks or string attachments will be illegal.
- 7. One anchor point only is permitted.
- 8. The archer shall touch the arrow when nocked and drawing the arrow with the index finger against the nock. Finger position may not be changed during competition. In the case of physical disability of the arms or hands, a chew strap may be used in place of fingers.
- 9. Gloves, tabs or fingers shall be the only legal releases. In the case of physical disability of the arms or hands, a chew strap may be used in place of fingers.
- 10. All arrows shall be identical in length, weight, diameter and fletching with allowance for wear and tear.
- 11. One straight stabilizer, coupling device included, if used, which cannot exceed 12 inches at any time as measured from the back of the bow.
- 12. No written memorandum will be allowed.
- 13. Bow Slings are permissible.
- 14. During a round no adjustments may be made to the bow and/or its related equipment unless equipment failure is recognized.

RATIONALE: (Describe briefly existing problem and expected benefit of proposed change)

Since the introduction of the new Barebow Recurve style in 2019, it has been clearly demonstrated that it is a well-attended style, especially at Vegas. The COVID pandemic of 2020/2021 has made it difficult for many to attend tournaments, but in the events that do occur, Barebow Recurve competitors are making a good showing. Even the Dakota Classic has drawn competitors to compete at national level events and state level.

The future growth of archery requires bringing up our young to enjoy the sport. Outside of Freestyle and Bowhunter, our youth is primarily pointed towards three shooting styles, which limits their exposure to more traditional styles of shooting. When looking at the age demographics for the single-string shooting styles, the majority of the state and local shoots are shot by the senior age divisions. In World Field Archery championships there are Traditional style categories for the Young Adult age division, but not in the NFAA, so it makes it difficult for the US to raise up outstanding young shooters.

Because of this, a motion is being made to add Young Adult to the Barebow Recurve style, and to expand the age divisions to also include Silver Senior and Master Senior age categories.
