2024 CBH/SAA Annual Meeting Held at Visalia Marriott February 24-25, 2024

The minutes from the 2023 meeting were presented. Ron Peery motioned to accept them as written, Kevin Wright 2nd, passed.

Officer Reports;

President – Chriss Bowles noted that he taught 12 Hunter Education classes, shot the Broadhead for the first time and placed 2nd. Helped with the Raahauge's Youth Shoot and thanks to Oranco, Cherry Valley and the Ison's for helping out. Also helped at the Sportsman's Caucus at Yolo and attended multiple Fish and Game Commission meetings.

VP – Alan Eagleton reported that he ran the State Traditional shoot, had a couple of glitches but the weather cooperated, had 168 archers, CBH/SAA net was \$4,046.36. For 2025, Lodi Bowmen will host.

Secretary – Pam Severtson reported NFAA membership is up, CBH down a bit, but maybe because they joined CBH. New member apps are in everyone's folder, discard of old ones at the shops and clubs and use the new ones.

Treasurer – Via Chriss Bowles, vocally, Stephan Grothues not able to attend this year, report is in your packets, cd's are making over 3% interest, Big Game made some \$ this year, with consolidating and investing appropriately, we are in the right direction.

Ron Peery motioned to seat MTBA Leg Rep Sarath Changaramkumarath and CCB President Dale Johnson. Jeff Franklin 2nd, passed.

2nd VP Hunting – Rodney York thanked all delegates for letting him serve, thanks to Pam Severtson and Lori Raupe for their support and guidance, thanks to Chriss Bowles for his involvement in the BGC meetings (hasn't seen that type of involvement in a CBH President) and thanks to the continued leadership of the BGC committee. He mentored an elk hunt in AZ, 2 youth hunts, father and son javelina hunt. BGC is solvent and financially strong, 32 recording period ends soon. Will present a Whitney Hill award tonight. Thanks to David Bacon too. Record book is not close to publishing yet. Broadhead divisions need to be trimmed, buckle as an award. Memorial Day weekend is the Broadhead at Lodi Bowmen. BGC would like the payout to host to be changed. Lodi Bowmen repaired the tires on the trailer, thank you! And, he will defer on Small Game report.

2ndVP Field – Robert Tehee reported this was his first year and it had some hiccups, biggest turnout in years, had S/W Sections too. State Marked 3d was at Oranco with \$10 per head to Oranco, had 119 shooters and clear \$5520. Get the single string class on board w/ NFAA and we are doing a disservice to them when they go to Nationals. He removed 3 persons from the shoot for unsportsmanlike behavior.

2nd VP Target – Lisa Rodriguez reported thanks to the host sites and Karen Keating. Requested that persons use the email and phone number on flyer. 516 registered archers, highlight was seeing the broken records. \$11,054.27 was the net income. Regfox is the system used. 2nd VP Indoor – Per Chriss Bowles, Dawnel Scott had resigned and would like to introduce Brian Webb, owner of Impact Archery and an accomplished archer. Indoor issues were on Chriss's shoulders. Last years indoor results are not totally completed, still wrapping it up financially. From Brian Webb, thanks to Pam Severtson, Gary McCain, Sandy McCain and David Bacon for their help. He asked his wife for help and he has learned a lot. The host should be accountable for the scorecards, rules and explanations. Once you understand how it works then it makes sense. Way too many classes.

2nd VP Target – Lisa Rodriguez added that she created a pdf and 900 round video.

Per Chriss Bowles, no USA reciprocity agreement any more, period.

Legislative Director – Amanda Duchardt thanked to all who attended Friday's meeting. Catalina Island was huge discussion. We need to maintain good stewardship, continue to raise legislative defense funds, submitted petitions to go over later. Gaines and Associates is now \$20,000. Due to the membership fee increase, looking to have line item for Leg Defense. Also, presented Challenge coins at the Friday meeting.

IBEP Chairman – Johnnie Waddles stated that in person classes started slow, the online and field classes were about the same as last year. Shawn Olague is now the captain. For the Sportsman's Caucus, Bill Gaines asked for help and Maya Archers helped, but the date changed a couple of days before and inland hunting season had opened and not as many helpers were there. Chriss Bowles helped out a lot. Next year for the Sportsman's Expo in January, we need help to get that done. Pam Severtson explained that there was the Tod Hawkins Memorial Shoot that same weekend, which archers attended that instead.

Newsletter Editor – Per Chriss Bowles, Lori Raupe not able to attend but agreed to continue on. Webmaster – David Bacon reported it was a rough year, still having problems with Go Daddy. May end up going through the "cloud". We are in shared hosting now and the website continues to go down. The 1st year with a new system may be 3 x as much as what we are paying now, but it will go down each year. Within the next 7 months, we will have a new web service when Go Daddy comes up for renewal. David requested that 2nd VP's get information to him for the dedicated pages.

NFAA Director – Gary McCain said thanks for letting him be the Director. He wants everyone to read the Bylaws. Gary will write an agenda item and present to NFAA. Range inspections is new this year where NFAA is allowing the clubs/shops to do their own as long as no major change. The issue with an individual charging a range inspection fee has been resolved. The national meeting used to be 2-3 days, this year they crammed in one day and were not able to go over

many items, met from 8am to 730pm. Gary tried getting an additional vote for CA but got the stink eye.

S/W Councilman – Tom Daley reported that they all have zoom meetings with 1 in house per year. The bowhunting side and the target side in other states are not getting along nicely, need to come together. We out grew Vegas at Southpoint. Over the past few years, Bruce Cull has been working on it. Vegas will be in March 2025. He gets calls from other states and countries asking questions, that he gladly answers. Break the Barriers will have now have a 1 arrow national championship tournament in 2024. Wilderness Archery in Rocklin will be having a Customer Appreciation Day on March 9th and is giving a booth to CBH/SAA and Wilderness will be giving a \$100 gift card for anyone joining CBH/SAA.
