



# NFAA SHOOTER OF THE YEAR - RULES

Updated & effective 01/01/2024

Each year, the NFAA awards the title of “Shooter of the Year” (SOY) to three professional archers and two amateur archers.

## To qualify, archers must shoot all of the following tournaments:

- The Vegas Shoot
- NFAA Indoor Nationals
- First Dakota Classic
- NFAA National Marked 3D
- NFAA Outdoor National Field

Points are calculated by adding final scores from all 5 events plus the final X count for The Vegas Shoot, NFAA Indoor Nationals, and the First Dakota Classic. Each X counts as an additional point.

## Professional SOY Categories

- Professional Male
- Professional Female
- Professional Senior

## Professional SOY Details

- Archers who have competed in a Professional division or have won \$250 or more in an Adult Championship or Senior Championship division in the current year are considered Professional for SOY purposes.
  - A podium bonus is awarded for the top 3 scores at all 5 events in the male and female categories (3 points for 1st place, 2 points for 2nd place, and 1 point for 3rd place).
  - Payouts are awarded to SOY winners based on the number of professional memberships in the male, female, and senior categories.

## Amateur SOY Details

- Archers who have competed in the following divisions during the year are considered Amateur for SOY purposes: Flights, Adult, Senior, Cub, Youth, Young Adult, or Young Adult Championship.
