

NFAA SHOOTER OF THE YEAR - RULES

Updated & effective 01/01/2024

Each year, the NFAA awards the title of "Shooter of the Year" (SOY) to three professional archers and two amateur archers.

To qualify, archers must shoot all of the following tournaments:

- → The Vegas Shoot
- → NFAA Indoor Nationals
- → First Dakota Classic
- → NFAA National Marked 3D
- → NFAA Outdoor National Field

Points are calculated by adding final scores from all 5 events plus the final X count for The Vegas Shoot, NFAA Indoor Nationals, and the First Dakota Classic. Each X counts as an additional point.

Professional SOY Categories

- → Professional Male
- → Professional Female
- → Professional Senior

Professional SOY Details

- Archers who have competed in a Professional division or have won \$250 or more in an Adult Championship or Senior Championship division in the current year are considered Professional for SOY purposes.
- A podium bonus is awarded for the top 3 scores at all 5 events in the male and female categories (3 points for 1st place, 2 points for 2nd place, and 1 point for 3rd place).
- Payouts are awarded to SOY winners based on the number of professional memberships in the male, female, and senior categories.

Amateur SOY Categories

- → Amateur Male
- → Amateur Female

Amateur SOY Details

 Archers who have competed in the following divisions during the year are considered Amateur for SOY purposes: Flights, Adult, Senior, Cub, Youth, Young Adult, or Young Adult Championship.
