Submit State Event Results & News: State associations are required to host one Indoor State Championship and one Field State Championship annually. If a Field round is not feasible, a Target State Championship may be held. The official results should be submitted following each event. A news release will be published on the state landing page featuring the results, photos, and any other tournament content.

Club/Shop Charter Approval: Clubs and shops typically apply for membership directly through Sport:80. Once paid, the State Director is notified to approve or deny the application. Requests should be handled promptly. State associations may **ONLY** deny club or shop membership if the minimum membership requirement is not met (5 members for clubs, 1 for shops) or special circumstances apply, in which case a petition must be filed by the state and approved by the Council.

MEMBERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Range Certifications: Range certifications are offered to all NFAA clubs and shops, as well as recognized municipalities and state agencies. A valid range certification is **required** for any NFAA club or shop to host NFAA events. All inspections must be completed online; paper forms are not accepted. Most inspections do not require an on-site visit by a State Director or approved inspector. Once submitted, the State Director is notified to review and e-sign the inspection form for approval or denial. Prompt attention is important. All certified ranges have the option to appear on the public NFAA Range Finder. Review the Range Certifications page for the full process and additional details.

Club/Shop Referral Program: NFAA Clubs and Shops can earn referral funds for each new NFAA member they recruit during the calendar year by completing a simple online referral form.
